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ABOUT THE MINNESOTA CHIROPRACTIC ASSOCIATION

Formed in 1927, MCA is the only professional organization that solely represents doctors of chiropractic in Minnesota.

MCA is divided into seven geographic districts to facilitate networking opportunities and camaraderie among members from across the state.

LEADERSHIP AND ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

MCA is a volunteer-driven organization that is governed by an Executive Committee and a Board of Directors that formulate the association's strategic plan and policies, oversee its financial, organizational, and operational activities, and foster its mission and vision. MCA actively promotes a code of ethics designed to help maintain a high level of professional and personal conduct. Several committees assist the president and board of directors. Through the work of its board of directors, officers, and various committees, MCA is able advance, promote and protect chiropractic in the state of Minnesota.

Executive Committee

MCA's Executive Committee is comprised of officers who are elected by membership to lead the association. The officers consist of a president, first vice-president, second vice-president, secretary, and treasurer. The term for each elected officer is one year or until a successor is elected.

Board of Directors

The Board of Directors consists of the executive committee and district directors, and the immediate past-president. The board can also include no more than two non-DC members of the public, and a representative from the American Chiropractic Association. Each board member serves a one-year term or until a successor is elected.

Districts

MCA is comprised of seven districts: Central, MetroEast, MetroWest, Northeast, Northwest, Southeast and Southwest districts. Each district has one district director, except for the MetroEast and MetroWest districts, which has two district directors. Members of their respective districts elect their director who serves a term of three years, or until a successor is elected.

- 2. Select the "Member Central" tab near the top of the home page.




Complete Your Profile


