## CHIROPRACTIC COVERAGE ELIMINATED

## Effective January 1, 2026:

Chiropractic care will **no longer be covered** under **Medical Assistance/Medicaid and MinnesotaCare/MNCare for adults age 21 and older.** 

This change was included in the Governor's budget and passed during the June 2025 legislative session. It applies to all MA and MNCare plans, including third-party plans such as UCare, HealthPartners, Blue Cross Blue Shield/Blue Plus, UnitedHealthcare, Medica, **and all others.** 

## What this means

- If you are age 21 or older and on Medical Assistance/Medicaid or MinnesotaCare/MNCare, your visits will not be covered starting January 1, 2026. You will be responsible for all associated costs of care.
- This cut removes access to chiropractic care for thousands of Minnesotans who rely on it to manage pain, avoid medications, and stay active.
