



The Minnesota Chiropractic Association continues to advocate at the Capitol. President Dr. Adam Millsop and Past President Dr. Doug Broman recently testified before the Minnesota House Health Finance and Policy Committee in support of H.F. 4048 with Representative Robbins.

This bill would remove chiropractors from the provider tax while Minnesota Medical Assistance does not offer a chiropractic benefit to all beneficiaries. Our advocacy efforts underscore the ongoing need to reinstate chiropractic coverage under Medical Assistance.
